In this kitchen, we've chosen rich, vintage Krylon colors like Burgundy and Hunter Green, along with Oyster Gray and Almond Satin to accent. By painting just a few objects in coordinating colors, you can enhance a neutral room.

### Stools

Unfinished or painted wooden stools should be sanded and primed before spraying your color. To paint the stool top a different color from the legs, as we did, refer to masking tips, page 6. Mask the legs first and then paint the stool top. When dry, mask the top and paint the legs.



### Fruit Bowl

If your bowl is made of plastic or ceramic, use a fine sand paper to rough up the surface so that the paint adheres better. Only paint the outside of the bowl if you're using it for food.

### Baskets

Sturdy reed and straw baskets lend an "Old World" feel to our kitchen. Refer to masking tips (on page 6) when using more than one color. First, spray the entire basket the light color. When dry, mask outside the areas where you're adding an accent color and then spray.

### Key & Letter Holder

Turn this project into a "key" focal point in your kitchen, by painting it with Krylon Teal Blue. Use a primer on bare wood or metal before spraying your color.



### Wine Rack

Krylon Purple is a great "vintage" color for this metal wine rack. Use a primer first on metal surfaces for better paint adhesion.

Use Krylon Appliance Epoxy to update your appliances. It comes in most of today's appliance colors. It's easy to use. Remove the handles and knobs. Mask off the rest and spray. Appliance Epoxy dries to the touch in 30 minutes. (Not for use on kitchen stoves)
